# **Multimedia: Digital Art with Photoshop**

**Dates:** September 11- October 23, 2013 (7 weeks)

**Objective:** Students will learn to digitally manipulate photos and create special effects in Adobe Photoshop. Students will learn to manipulate lighting, exposure, filters, and shading with the click of a mouse. They will re-size, crop, mask, blur and use various filters to create compelling artwork and graphics. Students will experiment with brushes, tools, the drawing tablet, and custom colors to create all new images. Turn a photograph into a charcoal drawing! Interchange subjects and their backgrounds! Ever wanted to turn your friends into zombies or place them on the moon? With Photoshop anything is possible!

#### **Skills Learned**

- Cropping techniques and how to choose the focus of the image.
- Use of drawing tablet to create professional
- Import images into Photoshop projects.
- Tools and brushes.
- Choose colors and change the look of images.
- Photo manipulation.
- Work with visual effects: manipulation of light in the image.
- Learn brush techniques and their uses.
- Experiment with shading.
- Apply filters and special effects.

#### The Charcoal Effect

- Import images into Photoshop.
- Choose the focus of the image, crop and edit.
- · Using a filter, transform the image into a "charcoal drawing."
- 3. Manipulate an image.
  - Work with layers, photo manipulation.
  - Take a landscape photo of summer and make it look like a winter scene.
- 4. Screen Savers
  - Choose and edit an image.
  - · Learn how to save it as a background for a computer.
- 5. Energy Ball
  - Take a photo of students holding the amethyst ball.
  - Control the light on the image to create effects.
  - Use visual effects: shadows, glows, borders.
- 6. The Avatar Project
  - Using special effects and tools, students transform themselves into avatar characters.
- 7. Graphic Design
  - Design an image using the techniques learned during the session.
  - Print it onto a t-shirt.
