Thank you for your interest in the Alpha Rho chapter of Eta Sigma Alpha, the National Homeschool Honor Society. The mission of Eta Sigma Alpha (HSA) is to recognize and encourage scholarship and academic excellence among homechooled students; to create opportunities for leadership through self-governance of the student-led organization; to foster networking and socializing in a supportive, accepting, intellectual climate; and to perform community service. For many, HSA will provide a noteworthy extracurricular activity and credential on future college or scholarship applications.

A copy of our complete chapter by-laws and more membership details are posted on the Alpha Rho webpage. To qualify, a student must be a homeschooled student in 8th-12th grade (minimum age 13 by September 30 of the membership year.) An applicant must have test scores in the top 90% on one of several, recognized national tests (see application or bylaws), and must be in good standing with the school district as a homeschooler. Meetings are held on the second Friday afternoon of each month from 3:00 pm- 4:15 pm, and there are minimum attendance and participation expectations. New members are accepted year-round.
